Tradewind streamlines Boston-area travel with a time-saving alternative departing from Hanscom Field (BED) this summer

March 24, 2026 (Oxford, Connecticut) – [Tradewind Aviation](#), a leader in private aviation and pioneer of the shared charter model, announced today new scheduled flight service from Hanscom Field (BED) to Martha's Vineyard (MVY) and Nantucket (ACK). Launching June 18th, the new routes will enhance connectivity for Boston-area travelers seeking seamless access to these popular coastal destinations.

The new service is designed to deliver a more efficient and seamless travel experience for Tradewind guests, eliminating many of the challenges associated with commercial departures from Boston Logan International Airport—including TSA screening and lengthy boarding processes. Instead, travelers can depart from a private terminal at Hanscom Field in Bedford, where they can check their luggage directly with the Tradewind team, arrive just 30 minutes before departure, and only need to take a few steps to the aircraft for boarding. On board Tradewind's Pilatus PC-12, operated by two pilots for enhanced safety, guests enjoy a smooth, efficient flight, lasting approximately 30 minutes. Tradewind also offers complimentary snacks and refreshments, including beer and wine onboard.

"We got our start in the Northeast catering to clientele who wanted the comforts of private air service to reach their vacation homes on Nantucket, and we have been innovating and expanding in the region ever since," noted David Zipkin, Co-Founder and Chief Commercial Officer of Tradewind Aviation. *"With our new scheduled service out of Hanscom Field, travelers from the Boston area and beyond can enjoy a more seamless and convenient travel experience, from easy check-in to quick boarding, while we continue to expand and enhance access to popular destinations throughout the region."*

Celebrating its 25th anniversary this year, Tradewind Aviation's new service represents a key milestone in the company's continued growth, expanding its reach to serve more travelers seeking a premium, efficient way to fly throughout the Northeast. In 2025, Tradewind saw a 20%

increase in bookings across the region, leading to the decision to expand scheduled service to Nantucket from seasonal to year-round. Additionally, travelers can enjoy Tradewind's new private lounge at Nantucket Memorial Airport (ACK), an exclusive and quiet space detailed with signature comforts and conveniences, including complimentary snacks and refreshments.

- New scheduled flights from Hanscom Field (BED) to Martha's Vineyard (MVY) and Nantucket (ACK) are available to book now, with flights starting June 18th.
- Fares start at \$295 one-way (plus taxes and fees) to Martha's Vineyard, and \$330 one-way (plus taxes and fees) to Nantucket.

Timing:

- 3 daily round-trip flights between BED & MVY and between BED & ACK.
